ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE:

Participation in the German University Championships (DHM) and the Newcomers-Cup is possible without a competition licence from a national or international judo federation. The minimum graduation must be proven at the scales (with judo pass or competition licence or examination certificate of the national judo association). For participation in the Newcomers-Cup, the exact graduation must be proven (with a document from the national judo association).

Extension of the starting authorisation for participants from the Netherlands, Belgium, and Luxembourg:

All members of institutions that are universities or universities of applied sciences in the respective country according to national law are eligible to participate. Participants from the Netherlands, Belgium and Luxembourg recognise the competition regulations of the adh with their registration. They are also obliged to provide proof of their student or employee status at university as part of the accreditation process. The details of the evaluation of international participants will be explained at the team leaders meeting on Friday, 6th of December 2024.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE NEWCOMERS-CUP:

- (1) All athletes who fulfil the conditions of eligibility and whose current graduation does not exceed 3rd kyu are eligible to compete.
- (2) All athletes who fall into this category (1) are free to compete in the DHM Team competition as alternative.
- (3) A simultaneous registration of athletes for the DHM Individual and the Newcomers-Cup is possible if (1) it fulfilled, whereas a simultaneous registration for the DHM Team and the Newcomers-Cup is excluded.

PLEASE NOTE:

The consumption of alcohol, cannabis and other drugs in the designated competition areas is prohibited during the entire course of the event. Participation in competitions under the influence of alcohol and / or other drugs is prohibited. Violations will be sanctioned.

Doping test are carried out at adh events.

TEAMLEADERS MEETING: The team leaders meeting will take place on **Friday, 6th of December 20:30** in the gymnastics room (competition hall). This is a mandatory part of the event. One

representative per university must attend the meeting.

REGISTRATION: Non-member universities and universities of applied sciences from the

The registration must be confirmed by the university management. Indi-

vidual registrations without confirmation from the institutions will not be considered.

COMPETITION RULES: German Judo Federation e.V. (DJB)

REGULATIONS FOR TEAM MATCHES:

(1) Each team consists of six judoka (three female, three male) in the following weight categories from the same university.

(2) Women: -57 kg, -70 kg, + 70kg

Men: -73 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg

- (3) At least four weight categories must be occupied in each team match.
- (4) Three competitors can be weighted in each weight category. Each competitor can start in his/her weighed-in weight class or in a weight class one step higher.
- (5) A new team line-up can be formed each team match, which must be submitted in written form to the sports manager.
- (6) The first order of the weight categories will be drawn before the competitions. The order of the weight classes will be changed in the following rounds according with the guidelines of the International Judo Federation (IJF).
- (7) The team lists of all participating teams must be handed to the technical delegate (Mo Belmann) by 4 pm on the day before the team competition. The officials are responsible for checking the team list. Judoka who are not on the team list are not authorised to compete on Sunday.
- **(8)** If a team has won four individual matches, the remaining matches are not fought out and the team match ends.
- (9) Results:
 - a. Number of single matches won
 - b. In the event of a tie: Draw for a single match. Realisation of the fight as a golden score contest.

REGULATIONS FOR THE NEWCOMERS-CUP:

Fights will be organised according to the regulations for team matches (see above) and the weight categories for the Newcomers-Cup. The teams may be supplemented with fighters from other universities. **Starting in more than one team is permitted.**

The matches are **not** finished, if a team has one four individual matches. All matches will be fought out.

A team must consist of at least four judoka with at least one woman or one man.

Judoka who does not have a team, fulfil the requirements for the Newcomers-Cup and would like to take part in the competition can register for the **exchange market** at the following link: https://tally.so/r/mKDaiK

The teams will be announced by the Technical Delegate during the team leaders meeting. The registered judoka must pay the respective share of the entry fee on the competition weekend.

MINIMUM KYU:

The minimum graduation for individual and team competition (including Newcomers-Cup) is the yellow belt (7^{th} Kyu).
